

Knighlab StoryMap Tutorial

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1. Go to: <http://storymap.knightlab.com> or google: Knightlab Storymap
2. Click on “Create” on top left corner of the screen
3. Create a free account using any gmail account.
4. Click on “Map” to start your story map
5. Create a title for your story map (This can be edited later if needed)
6. You can then put that title on the opening slide of your map as well, or any other title you would like. The highlighted red slide on the left side of the screen is your opening slide and will not have an exact location with it
7. Click on “Add Slide”
8. To add a location you can type directly in the “Search” bar. You can search by exact address, keywords, landmarks, etc.
9. You can add a title to that exact location by typing in the “HEADLINE” space, add text using the text box below the “HEADLINE” space, add a picture, image, video, multimedia on the left side by entering the exact URL or uploading the media. You can then add a caption or credit for that specific media.
10. You can add a background image for each individual slide by clicking on “Slide Options” on the bottom right corner of the screen” You can then again put an exact URL or upload an image
11. Make sure to save your progress as you go by clicking on “Save” on the top left of the screen
12. You can change fonts, style of the map, and more by clicking on “Options” on the top left of the screen
13. When all of your points are finished you can click on “Share” on the top right of the screen and you will be given an active URL that will take you to your story map (You can still edit and add to your story map after making the link active)

14. To stop and work on it later just make sure to save it and then go back in the same way you did the first time and there will be an option to continue to edit an already started story map
